Reply by way of an affidavit of Manoj Kumar, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Pathankot on behalf of the State of Punjab, has been filed in Court, the same is taken on record.

The learned counsel for the petitioner states that the voice sample has already been given to the CFSL. It is further contended that the authenticity of the CD is not established and that the evidence of sting operation is not admissible in evidence.

In the circumstances, when the sample has already been taken, let all the pleas regarding authenticity of CD and non-admissibility of evidence be taken before the lower Court.

The petition is accordingly disposed of with the above noted observations.
