The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.19,
dated 18.1.2015, registered under Sections 302, 307, 452, 34 of the IPC,
at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has
been in custody since 30.1.2015 and there is no attribution of any injury

to the deceased by the present petitioner and the only allegation against

him is that he had dragged out the wife of the deceased.

The matter was being adjourned from time to time to enable the wife of the deceased (complainant) to complete her deposition. It is not disputed that she has concluded her deposition wherein she has only stated that the petitioner had dragged her out of the car.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of.
