Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner-Avtar Singh in case FIR No.6 dated 16.01.2016, under Sections 336, 341, 506, 427, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 307, 120-B, IPC added subsequently), registered with Police Station Jodhan, Tehsil and Distt. Ludhiana.

Complainant-Inderjit Kaur is wife of Inspector Gurmit Singh and the relation between the two are estranged, as it is alleged that he has illicit relations with Amandip Kaur. According to the complainant, when she accompanied by her son-Amrit Inder Singh were travelling in a car, accused party comprising Amandip Kaur, her sister-Gurpreet Kaur and petitioner-Avtar Singh had waylaid them and the petitioner/accused is alleged to have fired a shot from his licensed revolver.

It was contended that it is a case of no injury and petitioner has nothing to do with the inter-se dispute between the two parties.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by SI Sukhvinder Singh and learned Counsel for the complainant, concedes the aforesaid factual situation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted by this Court, vide order dated 01.04.2016, is made absolute.
