Prayer in this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the accused/petitioner-Lakhbir Singh @ Gadi in case FIR No.23 dated 17.02.2012, for offence punishable under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short 'the N.D.P.S. Act) registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

The allegations are that the Mahindra Max vehicle was intercepted and a recovery of 630 kg. of poppy husk was effected while the co-accused Nirmal Singh @ Nimma was apprehended at the spot. The petitioner is alleged to have fled away.

The petitioner was declared proclaimed offender on 22.01.2013. He was taken in custody on production warrants on 23.09.2014.

It is contended that the co-accused Nirmal Singh has since been acquitted vide judgment dated 24.02.2016 (Annexure P2).

Learned State counsel assisted by HC Swaran Singh states that the petitioner is involved in 17 other criminal cases including 8 under the N.D.P.S. Act.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
