FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Report dated 11.04.2016 sent by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridkot has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Om Parkash @ Kakku, Paramjeet Singh and Jangi Sethi @ Bajrang Bali as well as of complainant Gurdas Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure personal fight over a trifling and that the parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.165 dated 28.07.2015 under Sections 341,295-A,323,34 IPC Police Station,

Kotwali, Faridkot and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
