After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and State counsel, it appears that the petitioner is also a complainant in a cross case under Section 377 IPC registered against complainant Sandeep who is complainant against the petitioner in this case alleging that the petitioner is guilty of offence under Section 377 IPC.

Taking into consideration the fact that both complainant and the petitioner are in custody since 18.01.2016, challan having already been presented, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that the petitioner will not indulge in similar activity during the pendency of the trial. In case of petitioner doing so, the bail would be liable to be cancelled.
