The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 261 dated 03.07.2015 registered at Police Station Rai, District Sonapat under Sections 304-B/34 IPC.

Petitioner is the mother-in-law. She is in custody since 23.07.2015. Three PWs till date have been examined.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had two sons and the husband of the petitioner had died in January 2015 and the elder son had got married prior thereto and there was no dispute and marriage of the second son took place in February 2015. The girl was not happy with the marriage and was interested in another boy and she left the house on 28.06.2015 saying that she was going for duty but did not go and later committed suicide. It was urged that the deceased was educated and was working and her entire salary was in her own account and false allegations have been levelled and the main witnesses have been examined.

The petitioner is in custody since 23.07.2015. The trial will take time.

Without commenting anything on the merits of the case and considering the fact that the trial will take time to conclude, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing local surety and adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
