Petitioners seek a direction that no FIR should be registered against him on the basis of the alleged complainants made by respondent No.5 and if the same is to be registered, he be given one week's time.

The police cannot be restrained from registering any FIR, if some cognizable offence is made out and there is no law that before registering the FIR, notice should be given to the accused.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
