Learned counsel for the complainant states that the petitioner is not paying the maintenance amount.

Petitioner would clear all the arrears within two months from today.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 30.03.2015 is hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner will join the investigation as and when required by the police and will not tamper with evidence or hamper the investigation and will not leave India without permission of the Court and will comply with the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
