This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.59 dated 15.03.2014, under Section 174-A of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Kotwali Faridkot, District Faridkot.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 13.01.2016:-

“Petitioner seeks the concession of pre-arrest bail in case F.I.R No.59 dated 15.3.2014 under section 174-A I.P.C registered at Police Station, Kotwali Faridkot, District Faridkot.

Counsel would submit that the petitioner was involved in a previous F.I.R No.249 dated 3.9.2010 under section 411 I.P.C registered at Police Station, City, Faridkot and in which he had been declared a Proclaimed Offender on 9.1.2014. Counsel would advert to order dated 8.9.2015 placed on record at Annexure P-1, whereby prayer for anticipatory bail pertaining to F.I.R No.249 dated 3.9.2010 after having

been declared a Proclaimed Offender, has been accepted.

Counsel furnishes an undertaking that the petitioner would duly appear even in the present case.

Notice of motion, returnable for 4.3.2016.

It is directed that in case the petitioner duly appears before the Trial Court within a period of 10 days from today, the petitioner would be entitled to ad interim protection as regards arrest subject to satisfaction of Trial Court.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from HC Sukhdata Pal informs the Court that the petitioner appeared before the trial Court on 15.01.2016 and has been admitted to interim bail on furnishing requisite bail bonds.

The petitioner having joined trial proceedings, prayer made in the present petition is accepted.

Petition is allowed. Order dated 13.01.2016, passed by this Court, is made absolute.
