The present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in FIR No.29 dated 03.04.2015, registered under Sections 392 and 395 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC') and Sections 141 and 152 of the Railways Act at Police Station GRP Kurukshetra.

Case file perused. It is averred in the petition that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case on the basis of the disclosure statement; no specific recovery was effected from the petitioner; and he is in custody since 14.04.2015.

On the other hand, the learned State counsel has furnished the chart of the cases in which the petitioner is involved. Same is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

I have heard the learned State counsel and carefully perused the entire file.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is involved in as many as seven FIRs mentioned in the chart, it emerges that the petitioner is a habitual offender. Therefore, no case is made out for bail.

Dismissed.
