Challenge in the present petition is to the levy of octroi on medicines. The writ petition was admitted. There is no interim stay granted. Meaning thereby, the petitioner may be paying octroi wherever it may be leviable in terms of the provisions existing at that time.

Learned counsel for the respondents submitted that octroi in the State of Punjab was abolished w.e.f. 1.9.2006.

Keeping in view the aforesaid development, we do not find that anything survives in the present petition. The same is, accordingly, dismissed.
