Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 01, dated 16.02.2015, under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station NRI Hoshiarpur.

Earlier petition filed by the petitioners i.e. CRM M-16966 of 2015 was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to surrender and move application for regular bail before the trial Court.

Now, the petitioners have filed second bail application. Once the petitioners have given undertaking to this Court that they would avail the remedy by filing application for regular bail, no ground for granting anticipatory bail is made out.
