This petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of direction to learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Malout to pass fresh order on an application under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C., in compliance of order dated 18.09.2015, passed by this Court in Criminal Misc.No.M-4925 of 2015, within a stipulated period as deemed fit and proper by this Court in the interest of justice.
