JASPAL SINGH, J.

This petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 65, dated 06.06.2007, under Sections 304-A & 427 of IPC, registered at Police Station Qadian, District Batala (**Annexure P-1**) along with all consequential proceedings arising out of the same on the basis of compromise (**Annexure P-3**).

2. In compliance of order dated July 14, 2015, statement of the parties have been recorded by the Appellate Court. Report of learned Additional District & Sessions Judge (A), Gurdaspur, has

been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that parties have arrived at compromise without any pressure or undue influence from any quarter. Even otherwise, matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

3. In view of the above, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

4. Consequently, instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 65, dated 06.06.2007, under Sections 304-A & 427 of IPC, registered at Police Station Qadian, District Batala and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
