The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No.183 dated 21.08.2012 registered under Sections 406 & 420 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act at Police Station Phase-I, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali).

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent/complainant submits that now compromise has been arrived at between the parties.

This Court had made order dated 24.08.2016 asking for recording of statement in order to find out the correctness and genuineness of the compromise said to have been arrived at between the parties.

Accordingly statements have been recorded by the trial Court and report has been received by this Court from the District and Sessions Judge,

S.A.S. Nagar. Looking to the report it is seen that the compromise is genuine and without any pressure. I have seen the offences registered against the petitioners. Looking to the nature of the offence I think the compromise/compounding should be allowed.

In view of the above, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) CRL. MISC. No.M-11221 OF 2016 is allowed.
- (ii) The FIR No.183 dated 21.08.2012 registered under Sections 406 & 420 IPC and Section 24 of Immigration Act at Police Station Phase-I, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali), is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.
