JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner-accused Dilpreet Singh in case FIR No.16 dated 05.02.2015, under Sections 307, 34, IPC (Section 341 IPC added later on) and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, registered with Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Ropar (**Annexure P-1**).

As per the allegations, the petitioner/accused-Dilpreet Singh along with his co-accused/non-applicants Jaspal Singh @ Jasi and Jagroop Singh came in a Swift Car and fired two shots with a country made pistol. The complainant-Bachittar Singh is alleged to have suffered three injuries i.e. two on the left arm and one on the left flank.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 27.02.2015 and only 2 out of 14 witnesses are stated to have been examined.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Vijay Kumar, submits that there is recovery of guns from the petitioner and he is stated to be involved in 13 other cases. He further submits that cross of the complainant and the testimony of other eye witnesses is yet to be completed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
