Petitioners, as members of unlawful assembly, on 20.12.2015 had allegedly assaulted the complainant – Nishan Singh and his family members. They were armed with weapons like kahi, kirpan, dang and datar etc. So far as the petitioners are concerned, petitioner No.1 was alleged empty handed but gave fist blows to the father of the complainant. Petitioner No.2 was allegedly armed with datar but has not been attributed any specific injury.

At this stage when the challan has already been presented and taking into consideration the cause of dispute being panchayat election, the petitioners can be granted the concession of bail as they have been in custody w.e.f. 16.01.2016.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
