This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.103 dated 13.12.2015 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326, 341, 506, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Nurmahal, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jagdish Kumar has accepted that pursuant to the order dated 17.05.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation. He further submits that order dated 01.04.2016 was passed on the averment that no grievous injury was attributed to the petitioner but actually there is one grievous injury which has been attributed to the petitioner but accepted that the said injury is on the lower part of the leg.

Resultantly, the petition is allowed. The interim order dated 01.04.2016 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
