Through the instant petition, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.35, dated 12.03.2016, registered under Sections 420, 498-A, 509, 120-B IPC, Police Station City Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to order dated 01.04.2016, passed by this Court, the petitioners had appeared before the Court below. He also states that in the enquiry the petitioners have been found to be innocent.
