The petitioner along with his sons Vishal and Sajan and 5-6 other persons armed with 'gandasi', knife and baseball bats had allegedly waylaid complainant Ravi and caused injuries.

On the instructions of ASI Rachpal Singh, learned State counsel informs that the complainant has not obtained radiologist opinion and injuries, till date, have been considered to be simple.

Taking into consideration the above said circumstances, the petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of petitioner, he will be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the condition that he will not tamper with the evidence or hamper the investigation in any manner. In case of any such eventuality, it will be open to the prosecution agency to seek cancellation of bail.
