Instant petition has been preferred under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, "Cr.P.C.") by Satyawan @ Kalu, seeking pre-arrest bail, feeling apprehension of his arrest, in case FIR No.104, dated 08.02.2016, under Section 306 IPC, Police Station City Hisar.

2. At the time of issuance of notice of motion vide order dated 01.04.2016, this Court has passed the following order:-

“Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case of abetment of suicide of Mohinder Singh who has allegedly left a suicide note. Counsel for the petitioner submits that name of the petitioner is not even mentioned specifically in the suicide note.

Notice to the Advocate General, Haryana, for
20.5.2016.

Meanwhile, an interim direction is issued that
the petitioner will join investigation on 9.4.2016 and
30.4.2016 or on any other date as required by the
Investigating Officer. In case of petitioner doing so, he
shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the
arresting officer.”

3. Learned State counsel, Ms. Neelam Kashyap, DAG,
Haryana has very fairly submitted that in compliance of orders dated
01.04.2016 and 20.05.2016, the petitioner has joined the investigation
and further his custodial interrogation is not required.

4. Taking into consideration the aforesaid facts of the case,
interim order dated 01.04.2016, is made absolute, subject to the
conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
