AJAY TEWARI, J. (Oral)

This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for
grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.28 dated

Police Station City Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 01.04.2016 the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation since the matter has been compromised.

Learned Additional Advocate General on instructions from Head Constable Harjinder Singh has accedpted this fact and stated that the petitioner is no more required for custodial interrogation. As regards the factum of compromise, she states that they have no official record of any compromise.

Be that as it may, without going into the merits of the case, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly.

Resultantly, the interim order dated 01.04.2016 is made absolute. Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
