Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Jasvir Kaur in case FIR No.09 dated 14.01.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 452, 323, 324, 148 & 149 Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, Jalandhar.

The occurrence is on 13.1.2016 at 11.45 PM at night. Petitioner along with her co-accused husband Jaswinder Singh @ Jassa and co-accused son Amarjit Singh and 4/5 other unidentified persons are alleged to have forcibly entered the house of the complainant-Gurpreet Singh @ Gopi, who is non else than the nephew of the husband of the present petitioner. The accused *Chachi* is alleged to have raised a *lalkara* and also caused a blow on the head of the complainant with a *datar* while the other non applicants/co-accused are alleged to have inflicted injuries upon the

complainant and his father Mohan Singh

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out, as the injury attributed to the petitioner on the left side of the head has resulted into fracture and thus opined to be grievous in nature.

In view of the nature and gravity of the allegations, petitioner is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

Dismissed.
