G.S.SANDHAWALIA, J. (Oral)

The petitioner was a work charge employee and discharged from service as Driver on 31.3.1993 on attaining the age of 60 years. The benefit of regularisation of service was never done in his case. The claim is for fixing pension and releasing all pensionary benefits along with consequential relief of arrears.

Counsel for the petitioner very fairly concedes that in view of the decision of the Full Bench of this Court in **Civil Writ Petition No.7072 of 1994-Lakha Singh Vs. State of Punjab and others** decided on 21.10.2015, the legal issue has already been decided against the petitioner wherein it has been held that work charge employee is not entitled to pension since engagement is governed by a different statute.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed.
