Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Jaspal Singh @ Sona in case FIR No.46 dated 16.04.2006 for offences punishable under Sections 452, 326, 324, 323, 427, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

It is stated that the petitioner upon grant of bail during trial and compromise effected between the parties was under the belief that his presence was no longer necessary. He soon thereafter left for France resulting into he being declared as Proclaimed Offender on 16.3.2009. In the meanwhile rest of the co-accused have been acquitted vide judgment

dated 24.02.2010 (P-3). Petitioner now wishes to join trial and has also placed on record affidavit of complainant and injured Baljinder Singh at P-4 agreeing the fact of compromise between the parties at this stage.

At the time of hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 14.01.2016, he surrendered himself before the trial Court and has been granted bail vide order dated 20.01.2016.

Learned State Counsel assisted by ASI Paramjit Singh is unable to refute the aforesaid submissions.

In view of the above, bail granted by the trial Court vide order dated 20.01.2016 pursuant to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 14th of January, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
