**M.M.S.BEDI, J.(ORAL)**

The petitioner has been found in possession of 20 vials of Rexcof at a point near Transport Nagar, Malwa College, Bhatinda.

Counsel for the petitioner has contended that the story of the prosecution is prima facie not supported by the scientific defence evidence available with the petitioner in the shape of tower locations which indicate that the Recovery Officer was present at Police Station, Thermal which is at a distant place as per the Google map placed on the record. Petitioner claims that he was at Paninsula Mall which is at a slight distance from Adarsh Nagar, the place of recovery.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case at this stage, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to the condition that the petitioner will not indulge in similar activity during the pendency of the trial.
