ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

The petitioner is seeking directions to respondent nos.2 to 3 conduct a free and fair investigation and to fairly investigate the role of respondents no.4 to 6 in case FIR No.11 dated 01.02.2016, registered under Section 498, 406 IPC at Police Station Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

The counsel for the petitioner contends that the complainant had named respondent no.4 to 6 of cruelty and misappropriation and during inquiry the police officials in connivance with the private respondents have not made them an accused and they were not willing to listen to the petitioner. It was urged that respondents no.4 & 5 were the unmarried sister in laws and directions be given to conduct free and fair investigation.

Police had registered the FIR on the complaint made by the petitioner. The FIR was lodged in February, 2016. No directions can be given to the police to investigate the matter in a particular manner. It is for the investigators to examine. No direction is required to be passed.

The petition is dismissed in limine.
