Through this petition preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, Narinder Kumar-petitioner has sought issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to take action against respondents No. 4 to 7.

Notice to official respondents, only, at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Rajpreet Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondents-State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to learned State counsel.

The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that representation/complaint dated 09.03.2016 (Annexure P-2) was moved

to Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur (Punjab) but till date no action has been taken.

The instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Ferozepur (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation/complaint dated 09.03.2016 (Annexure P-2) and proceed in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
