The petitioner is seeking quashing of the FIR No.64 dated 16.04.2009, under Sections 498-A, 406 and 494 IPC (Annexure P-1) registered at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

The said FIR was registered on the basis of complaint made by complainant-Navdeep Kaur (respondent No.2.) to the effect that her marriage was solemnized with petitioner-Jatinderpal Singh @ Jatinder Singh on 22.08.2007. Soon after the marriage, her in-laws started harassing and humiliating her on account of bringing insufficient dowry. Ultimately, she was thrown out of the matrimonial house. In this background, the FIR was registered.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 states that the complainant has received an amount of ₹ 8,00,000/- from the petitioner as full and final settlement.

In view of the said fact, this petition is disposed of by giving the liberty to the petitioner to take all the pleas before the trial Court.
