Petitioners, who are stated to be major, claim that they have married against the wishes of their parents on 27.3.2016. The photographs of the marriage have been placed on file as Annexures-P-2 and P-3. The certificate of marriage has been placed on file as Annexure-P-4. The duly sworn affidavit of petitioner No. 1, showing her date of birth has been placed on file. The true typed copy of PAN Card, issued by Income-Tax Department, showing the date of birth of petitioner No. 2, has been placed on file Annexure-P-1.

It is claimed that the petitioners have moved an application dated 27.3.2016 (Annexure-P-5) before the Superintendent of Police (Rural), Yamunagar, for protecting their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life from the private respondents No. 4 to 6.

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In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Superintendent of Police (Rural), Yamunanagar., to consider the application of the petitioners dated 27.3.2016 (Annexure-P-5) and assess the threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners and if it is found that there is danger to the life of the petitioners, necessary steps be taken to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners. However, this order shall not be construed as a recognition of valid marriage between the parties.

Disposed of accordingly.
