ANITA CHAUDHRY, J.

This is the second petition for grant of anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner in FIR No.60 dated 10.03.2015, registered under Section 370 IPC and Section 6 of POCSO Act, 2012, Police Station KUK (Kurukshetra), District Kurukshetra.

The counsel for the petitioner fairly concedes that the first petition had been withdrawn and the petitioner was directed to surrender before the trial Court. He urges that Sameem w/o Hifazat Ali has given an affidavit (Annexure P-6) that the petitioner was not involved, therefore, the petition had been filed again and the case was false. It was urged that the prosecutrix and her mother have not supported the prosecution case so far as the other accused are concerned.

A case had been registered of human trafficking. The petitioner had been named by the co-accused. The first petition was withdrawn by the petitioner as this Court was not inclined to grant bail.

The allegations were serious. The petitioner was directed to surrender before the trial Court. Instead of surrendering, he has approached the Court again. The petition is not maintainable and is dismissed.

The petitioner would surrender within a week.
