The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.78 dated 03.06.2015, registered under Sections 363/366-A IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012 at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner says that no allegations of rape had been made and the main witnesses have been examined and the petitioner is in custody since August, 2015.

The record shows that the girl had stayed with the boy for 19 days. No allegations of rape were made by her.

The trial will take long time to conclude. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on execution of adequate personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
