JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Jaspreet Singh @ Bali in case FIR No.05 dated 30.01.2016 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 353, 183, 332, 341, 148, 149 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Jhunir, District Mansa.

SHO/SI Jaskaran Singh came on the road at the site of accident between a motor cycle and the vehicle of a liquor contractor. The villagers of the village Mofar were agitating and tried to cause injury to the liquor contractor. The police party tried to restrain the crowd of 60/70 people, which was, *inter alia*, led by the present accused. Two of the co-accused Kulwinder Singh and Amrit Pal have also inflicted blows on the head and

chest of the complainant part from the dress of the constable Rajinder Singh having been torn off. The SHO was also pushed to the ground, whereby his turban was also unseated.

Counsel for the petitioner heard.

Keeping in view the nature and manner of commission of crime, which are on the rise, no indulgence can be shown by granting/extending the benefit of anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.

Dismissed.
