15 out of 18 witnesses stand examined against the petitioner in a case registered against him on the allegations that deceased Joginder Singh belonging to Delhi was killed by some unknown persons. Petitioner is not named in the FIR and the complainant witnesses have also not supported the case of the prosecution.

Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, the petitioner can be granted the concession of bail as he has been in custody w.e.f. July 28, 2015.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
