Petitioner along with his co-accused Amjad had allegedly escaped leaving a car with 197 kgs of poppy-husk. Co-accused of the petitioner, having been arrested after one and half year of the incident, has been granted concession of bail by this Court.

Pursuant to the interim order, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. His identity and involvement, in view of the nature of the allegations, will certainly be a debatable issue.

In view of said circumstances, the petition is allowed. Interim order dated 04.04.2016 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions that the petitioner will not indulge in similar activity and will not tamper with the evidence in any manner.
