For having been found in possession of non commercial quantity of powder containing Alprazolam salt, the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 24.2.2016. He remained on interim bail w.e.f. 27.11.2015 till abovesaid date during the period the report of Chemical Examiner was awaited.

Taking into consideration the fact that commercial quantity of Alprazolam salt has been recovered from the petitioner, no ground is made out to grant concession of bail. Dismissed. However, taking into consideration the fact that no witness has been examined till date, it is ordered that in case trial is not concluded within the period of six months after the next date of hearing fixed before the trial Court, trial Court itself shall release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction.
