Both the petitioners are in custody w.e.f. 13.11.2014 and 13.12.2014 respectively in a case registered at the instance of Ekjot Singh. The shop of the complainant Punjab Gun House was robbed and set on fire. The petitioners were involved in the case on the basis of statement of Hardev Singh and Paramjit Singh to the effect that on 19.10.2014 they heard petitioners No.1 and 2 and other persons planning to commit theft. On the basis of said circumstantial evidence the petitioners have been involved in the case.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that Hardev Singh and Paramjit Singh have already been examined and they have not supported the case of prosecution.

Taking into consideration this fact, the petitioners can be granted the concession of bail. The petition is allowed. The petitioners are ordered to be released on bail on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
