HARI PAL VERMA, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondents No.2 and 3 for taking appropriate action on the representation dated 3.3.2016 (Annexure P-1) moved by petitioner Dilpreet Singh to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana within reasonable time and for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of Gurpreet Kaur daughter of Darshan Singh, resident of Saholi, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel further submits that so far as representation regarding registration of the case against Gurpreet Kaur is concerned, he

may be permitted not to press the said prayer at this stage.

Ordered accordingly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that in order to seek protection of life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of said Gurpreet Kaur, he approached respondent No.2 by way of representation (Annexure P-1), but no action thereon has been taken.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Heard.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, and to pass necessary orders to ensure that no harm is caused to the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of aforesaid Gurpreet Kaur.
