Prayer made in the instant, petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to respondents No. 1 to 4 for providing police protection to the petitioner-firm, so as to enable it to perform labour/cartage contract of respondents No. 6 to 10 (different State procurement agencies), awarded to the petitioner-firm by respondent No.5, vide letter dated 29.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) for the year 2016-17.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner-firm was awarded contract by District Manager, Food and Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs, Sangrur, vide letter dated 29.03.2016 (Annexure P-3) for the year 2016-17, but the private

respondents have openly threatened and challenged the petitioner-firm that they will not allow the petitioner-firm to execute and discharge their obligations as set forth in the labour contract.

At this stage, Mr. Rajiv Kataria, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 11 to 15 and filed his Power of Attorney, which is taken on record.

Mr. Krishan Singh Dadwal, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No. 16 to 19 and filed his Power of Attorney, which is taken on record. He also filed reply on behalf of respondents No. 16 to 19 in Court today, which is taken on record.

Though, no such relief can be granted to the petitioner in the instant petition, filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., however, without commenting upon the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e. the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, Distt. Sangrur to consider the representation dated 25.03.2016 (Annexure P-5) submitted by the petitioner-firm and to take appropriate remedial action, as warranted by law.
