This order shall dispose of the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.85 dated 12.2.2016 under sections 420 I.P.C and section 61 (1) of Excise Act, registered at Police Station, Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the parties have been heard.

As per prosecution version, secret information having been received, a Mahindra XUV vehicle was intercepted and from where an alleged recovery of 108 bottles of Mcdowells, 108 bottles of Royal Stag, 24 bottles of Royal Challenge, 480 quarters of Mcdowells, 232 cans of beer was made.

Petitioner as also one other co-accused namely Prince were apprehended on the spot i.e. on 12.2.2016.

Investigation in the case is complete, challan stands presented and even charges have been framed.

The trial is stated to be at the very initial stage and would take time to conclude.

Petitioner has faced incarceration for a period in excess of three months as of date. Petitioner is not stated to be involved in any other case under the Excise Act.

Without making any observations on merits, present petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of C.J.M./Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.

Petition disposed of.
