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KULDIP SINGH J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he had made a representation to the police, which investigated the matter, but did not take any action as the civil dispute is pending. The learned counsel further contends that now, he has made further representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur and prayed for registration of a case against private respondents No. 4 and 5 and to protect his life and liberty from them.

In these circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, with his complaint and if no action is taken by the police, it shall always be open to the petitioner to approach the Illaqa Magistrate alongwith his appropriate complaint and prayer.
