Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the respondent No.3 for considering the complaint/representation of the petitioner and also to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondent No.5 and his accomplices.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has already approached respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana by way of representation dated 15.3.2016 (Annexure P-3), but no action thereon has been taken so far.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to hand over requisite number of complete copies of the paper book to learned State counsel during course of the day.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take note of the contents of representation (Annexure P-3) and to deal with the same in accordance with law.
