The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/accused-Major Singh in case FIR No.123 dated 13.11.2015, under Sections 323, 324, 326, 307, 341, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Amargarh, District Sangrur.

On the day of occurrence i.e. 11.11.2015 at 2:00 PM in the fields in possession of the complainant, the accused party is alleged to have gone there to take possession.

The present accused-Major Singh is allegedly armed with a *Iron Rod* and inflicted an injury below the knee of the left leg of the complainant-Kamaljit Singh, which has been found to be grievous in nature since a fracture of the bone has been found.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner/accused, keeping in view the nature of the injury attributed, no case for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
