Without expression of any opinion on merits of the case, it is sufficient to observe that the petitioner has been in custody w.e.f. 11.03.2016. The injuries suffered by the complainant appear to be on account of the collusion of two vehicles.

Recoveries have already been effected. It does not appear to be a case where petitioner should be detained during the entire period of trial.

The petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Illaqa Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Roop Nagar.
