**RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J.**

A request for adjournment made on behalf of counsel for the petitioner is rejected.

In view of stand taken in para.4 of the preliminary objections in the written statement filed by the Bank there is no life in this petition and the same is devoid of merit. The petitioner is a reserve category candidate and claims roster point promotion at points earmarked for members of the Scheduled Caste for promotion to the post of Accountant from feeder cadre of Junior Accountants. The Bank has affirmed in the written statement that all posts meant for reserve category for promotion comprising 38 Junior Accountants were already filled. The petitioner was at the tail end of the reserve category candidates and, therefore, cannot claim promotion out of turn in preference to general category candidates promoted to the higher

post.

The petition stands dismissed.
