Prayer is under Section 438 read with Section 482 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners, namely, Sham Lal and Harbans Lal booth sons of Birru Ram in a Criminal Complaint No.148 dated 25.04.2011 for offences punishable under Sections 302, 201, 120-B, 34 of the Indian Penal Code (Annexure P-1) pending before the Court of learned JMIC, Pathankot.

It is contended that deceased-Jeet Ram was an alcoholic and under the influence of liquor had fallen from the roof, resulting into his death.

The allegations against the petitioners have been investigated

by the police and they were found innocent and hence on the criminal complaint filed by the complainant-Naresh Kumar son of deceased-Jeet Ram, the petitioners have been summoned to face trial.

It is next contended that pursuant to the directions passed by this Court on 04.04.2016, the petitioners have surrendered on 11.04.2016 and granted interim bail and is ready to face trial.

Counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the confirmation of the bail.

In view of the above, interim bail granted by the trial Court pursuant to the directions passed by this Court vide order dated 04.04.2016 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
