The prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. to the petitioner/accused-Jitender Singh in case FIR No.218 dated 23.04.2013, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered with Police Station Bilaspur (now Police Station Manesar), District Gurgaon (**Annexure P-1**).

The land measuring 01 Kanal and 05 Marlas of the complainant-Uman Devi @ Urmila Devi was sold by the accused party vide Sale Deed dated 05.11.2012 for a sum of Rs.21,10,000/- to the co-accused/non-applicant-Rajwati.

The role attributed to the present petitioner is that he had impersonated as Neeraj Kumar and became a fake witness, who identified the co-accused imposter lady appearing in place of Uman Devi @ Urmila Devi (complainant) as the owner at the time of registration of the Sale Deed.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner by referring copy of School Certificate (**Annexure P-3**) submits that the petitioner was juvenile on the day of the execution of the forged Sale Deed and, therefore, is entitled to be released on bail.

After hearing leaned Counsel for the petitioner and perusing the pleadings, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out as the identity of the impersonator has yet not been located and to complete the chain of the investigation, the custody of the petitioner would be necessary as his name has been disclosed by the co-accused/non-applicant Sher Singh.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
