The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking bail in FIR No.158 dated 13.09.2015 registered under Sections 302 & 201 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The case of the prosecution is that the deceased was pushed from first floor and he fell down from the staircase and resultantly died. The case of the prosecution further is that the dead body was thereafter taken away and thrown at a distant place.

It is then stated by learned State counsel that there two witnesses have been examined by the trial Judge but they have not supported the prosecution version. Learned State counsel opposed the bail of the petitioner on the ground that the complainant is yet to be examined.

I have seen the complainants version discussed in the interim order passed by the trial court. Perusal of the same shows that the complainant has not seen the incident at all.

In the wake of above facts I think the petitioner should be released on bail.

In that view of the matter the following order is passed:

The petition is allowed and the petitioner be released on bail in FIR No.158 dated 13.09.2015 registered under Sections 302 & 201 read with Section 34 IPC at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda, upon the terms and conditions as will be decided by the Trial Judge.
