This is third application for regular bail.

On the instructions of ASI Paramjit Singh, learned State counsel informs that ten witnesses remain to be examined out of nineteen.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that the prosecution agency shall produce all the remaining witnesses within a period of three months after the next date of hearing. In case, the prosecution agency is not able to produce all the remaining witnesses within a period of three months from the next date of hearing, it will be open to the petitioner to approach this Court again for grant of regular bail.

It is expected that there will not be any evasive approach on the part of the accused or his counsel to delay the examination of the witnesses.
